Collective Purchasing Program

The Greater Boston Police Council (GBPC) administers a cooperative purchasing program for items such as police cruisers, medium and heavy duty trucks, motorcycles, hybrid vehicles, and numerous other industry specific commodities.

Since 2004, the GBPC has partnered with the Metropolitan Area Planning Council, who acts as purchasing agent for the GBPC and issues all bids and contracts in compliance with Chapter 30B. The MAPC is a public agency established in 1963 and is authorized to serve as a lead public entity for collective procurement activities. All GBPC members, including any member joining the GBPC as an ASSOCIATE member, is entitled to purchase equipment from this collective bid program. In addition, membership of one municipal department entitles all departments within that municipality to access this procurement program.
